



Tree-planting to achieve carbon neutral status

(Iceland)

We've committed to make our plant in Iceland the first carbon neutral site for CCEP. One way to achieve this is to offset our carbon footprint by planting trees. In 2018, in partnership with the Icelandic Forest Services (IFS) we launched a three-year project to plant trees in 4.5 hectares of land. Each hectare of forest can recover 4.4 tonnes of CO2 emissions. In 2018, we planted 1.5 hectares. This builds on previous partnerships with IFS dating back to 1989.
