



Camargue Wetland Restoration (France)

In 2014, in partnership with WWF France, The Coca-Cola Foundation began a two-phase project to restore and replenish the Camargue wetlands and their biodiversity. Phase one took place between 2014-2017 and was part of a wider programme to re-establish a more natural hydrological functioning of freshwater zones and to recreate and improve the water flow and biodiversity between the old Rhone, the lagoons and the Mediterranean Sea. Phase two began in late 2017 and the restoration works developed by the project will improve biodiversity and ecosystem services for at least 20 years. The project is due for completion in 2020. In 2018, this project helped to replenish 3,971 ML/y of water.
